TO BE GOING TO + INFINITIVE

- SHORT-TERM PREDICTIONS
- BASED ON WHAT YOU CAN SEE
- EG. (You look through the window and you see it is really grey and cloudy!)

You say: It is going to rain!



I THINK WE WILL STOP USING FOSSIL FUELS SOON

WILL + BARE INFINITIVE

- SHORT/LONG-TERM PREDICTIONS
- BASED ON WHAT YOU THINK. IT IS YOUR OPINION.
- EG. I think the Earth will explode in 3030.

I'm sure the scientist will find a vaccine for the Covid-19 next year.

- TO INTRODUCE UNCERTAINTY, YOU CAN USE MAY INSTEAD OF WILL.
- EG. I think we MAY begin the next school year with a new normality.
